### Open Enrollment for Dunkin'

### Important Dates to Remember!

October 31st - November 11th, 2022

Benefits will be effective January 1, 2023, thru December 31, 2023!

Any eligible Crew Members, Shift Leads & Managers can enroll, change or waive benefit coverages via the Paylocity Web Benefits Portal during this time period.

This will be a passive enrollment. If you are already enrolled, you will be automatically enrolled with the same coverages unless you enter the portal and make any changes!

If you are eligible and you don't enroll, or you wish to make changes to your current coverages and you do not during this Open Enrollment period, you will not be able to enroll or make changes until next year's open enrollment (unless you have a qualifying event - marriage, divorce, birth/adoption of a child, loss of other coverage).
